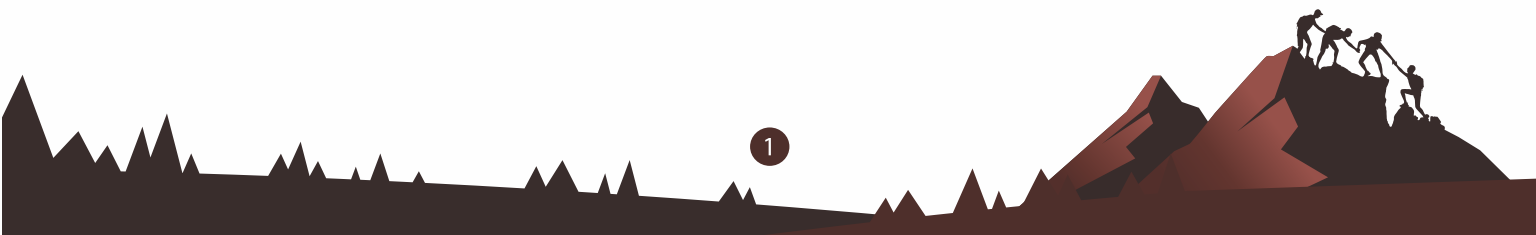

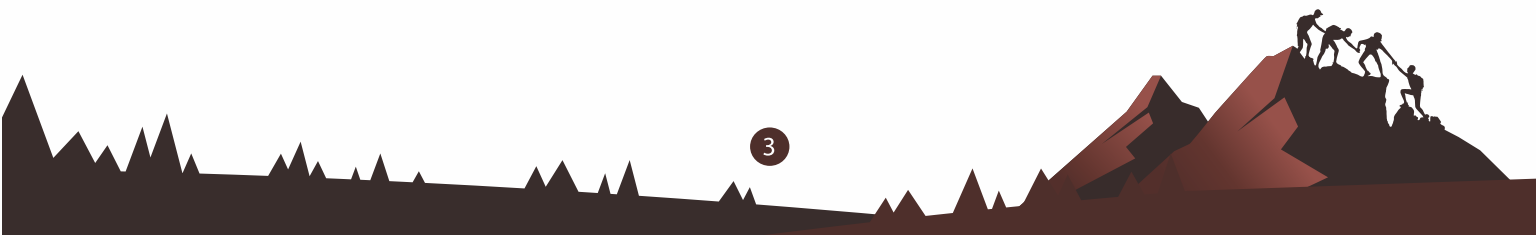
The Company was required to spend an amount of **₹10.91 crores** as CSR expenditure for the financial year ended 31st March 2021.

Prabhat Foundation has carried out a range of welfare programs and spent ₹166.87 lacs towards Medical, Education and other Assistance during the year 2020-21.

Financial Assistance for medical treatment was extended to those who suffered from Covid-19. The financial assistance was also given as death compensation to those who lost relatives due to Covid-19.

Assistance was extended for the cost of publishing manuals on medical information to professionals and free distribution of medicines. Financial help was also extended towards providing scholarships for pursuing fellow ship in medicine and also for infrastructure facilities to Government school for renovation of class rooms, furniture, computers etc were provided.

Contribution was also extended towards NGO working for mental retardation and developmental disability. Brief details of beneficiaries are given in the following pages.

Medical Assistance

Various Medical Assistance of ₹35.84 lacs was given to a range of beneficiaries.

Highlights of Medical Assistance:

- **11 Cancer patients were extended help of ₹3.65 lacs.**
- **07 Heart patients were extended help of ₹1.90 lacs.**
- **02 Kidney patients were extended help of ₹0.27 lacs.**
- **26 Covid-19 patients were extended help of ₹7.07 lacs.**
- **104 patients suffering from different types of ill health were extended aid of ₹20.56 lacs.**
- **Medicines worth ₹2.39 lacs were purchased and distributed amongst poor and needy.**

Educational Assistance

A) Towards Educational Assistance an amount of ₹66.63 lacs was extended towards underprivileged students for supporting educational amenities/services/fees.

B) Towards infrastructure development of school, an amount of ₹61.57 lacs was given towards the cost of civil, sanitation, gardening & electrical work at Jheerota (Ajmer), in Rajasthan.

A) Highlights of Educational Assistance:

- Financial help of ₹5.89 lacs was extended to poor and needy people for their educational assistance.
- 04 doctors were extended financial help of ₹13.05 lacs for pursuing fellowship in Medicines.
- An Amount of ₹23.32 lacs spent to purchase 104 Laptops for the needy and poor students whose education was interrupted due to lock down.



- An amount of ₹18.72 lacs was given as aid to the school towards Construction of Tin Shed, Kota Stone, PCC & Tiles work, at Govt. Senior Secondary School, Ramsar (Ajmer).



- An amount of ₹96,000 was given towards the sanitation work and sports kit at Govt. Ahilya Ashram Girls Higher Secondary School No.2.

- An amount of ₹4.70 lacs was given for purchasing one Solar Plant and Equipment Kit for e-learning classroom at Hilda Castelino School Laljipada through Rotary Club of Mumbai, Kandivali west.



B) Infrastructure Development of schools in Jheerota (Ajmer, Rajasthan)

- An amount of ₹7.77 lacs was given towards the sanitation work and gardening at Govt. Secondary School, Madanpura (Ajmer).
- Contribution of ₹3.35 lacs was given towards the sanitation work and gardening at KG Govt. Higher Secondary School, Arai (Ajmer).
- Financial help of ₹12.57 lacs was given towards the sanitation work and Tin Shed at Govt. Upper Primary School, Sarvar (Ajmer).



- An amount of ₹25,000 was given towards the development of greenery at Govt. Girls Primary School, Jheerota (Ajmer).



- ₹4.07 lacs was contributed towards sanitation work and Tin Shed at Govt. Upper Primary School, Dothali (Ajmer).



- A donation of ₹4.13 lacs was given for sanitation work and gardening work at K.G. Govt. Higher Secondary School, Jheerota (Ajmer).

- An amount of ₹6.44 lacs was given towards the sanitation work and Tin Shed at Govt. Upper Primary School, Gujarwada (Ajmer).



- ₹23.0 lacs was contributed for purchasing of Granite & tiles for infra work at Acharya Shree Dharmasagar Digamber Jain Vidyalaya, Madanganj (Kishangarh).



Others Assistance

An assistance of ₹2.81 lacs was given to various schools for infrastructure development.

- The Mrityunjai Bharat Trust, NGO registered under trust act at Indore in the 2009, which adopted 20 tribal childrens from 3 different states nearby Indore. For the accommodation, food & education facilities this year also, a contribution of ₹1.20 lacs was given to this NGO (last year same amount was contributed for same cause).

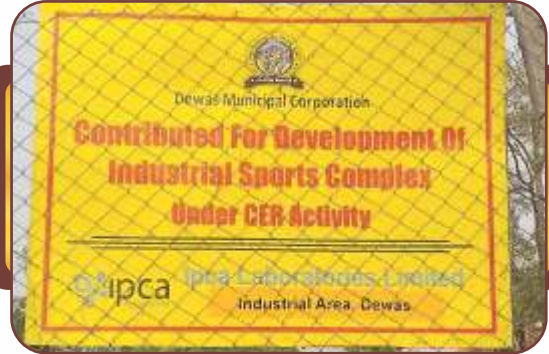
Tarapur

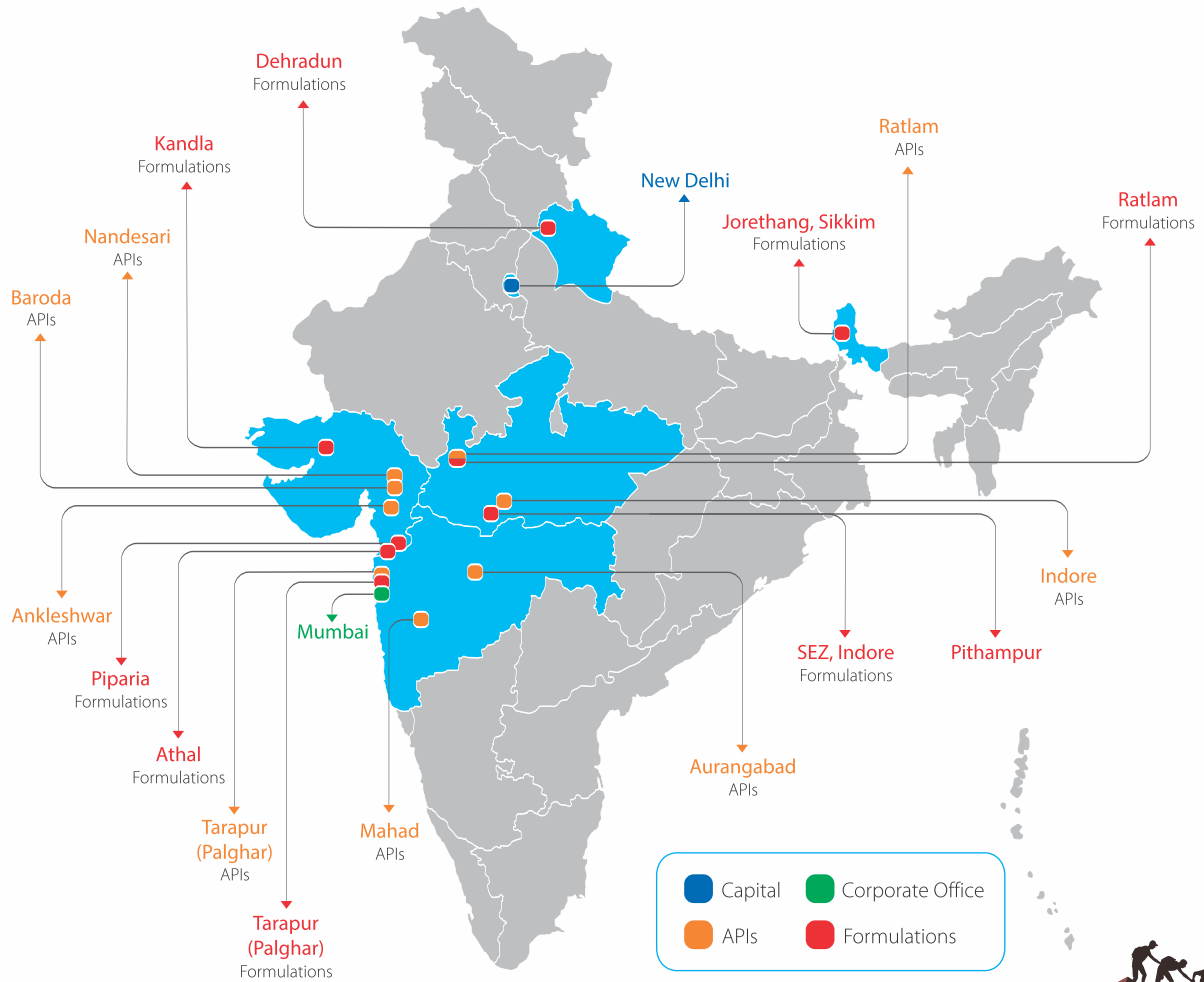
